



Friday, May 11, 2018

We had good weather and an easy clear-in at San Felipe. All the airplanes arrived at Robertson's Ranch in San Quintin by 10:45. We had brought quite a bit of equipment so we

used all three vans and crammed them full of people and supplies. We arrived at the clinic in El Rosario around 11:30 and got the clinic in operation.

Amie Stodder, a first timer, took us triage (wrestling the position from Scott Farris who likes to do it) while, another first timer, Lisa Soltani, and Patti Daly got medical up and running. Lisa was a great help, especially since she was fluent in Spanish having lived in Puerto Rico. Dental was manned by Ken Reed, Hunter Nash, Phoebe Blakeley and, of course, Linda Algar. This is where Scott finally settled. He loves assisting in dental and that's what he did, and, of course, his Spanish came in very handy. Bob Smith retreated into his lab and began his work on dentures.

We had 6 first timers on this trip, and among them was Peter Kaufer. Peter is an ophthalmologist and specializes in laser eye surgery. Part of the equipment we took down belonged to him. Although he didn't see any patients this clinic, he spent the time setting up his equipment so it will be ready when he returns, hopefully in September.

Another first timer was David Davis. Now, David is a prosthetist, that is, he is skilled in making and fitting prosthetic limbs. It was fortunate that David contacted us with an interest in going to the clinic. Last month we had a patient, Aldofo Loya Duarte, who had lost part of his leg in a boating accident. Needing a prosthetic lower part of his leg, he simply made one himself, but it was causing him some problems. We made sure Aldofo knew David would be at this month's clinic and sure enough he showed up. David spend most of Friday working on it and then sent Aldofo home asking him to return on Saturday. Not being a Spanish speaker, we had José Ralls, yet another first timer, interpret for him.

Maria Ralls, José's wife did interpretation for medical when needed and sorted out the drugs in the pharmacy. Also, Maria and José are part of the Southwest Medical Aide (SMA) organization. This organization supplies donated medical items to charities, such as the Flying Samaritans. They were impressed with the clinic and work we did, so some needed donations in the future may be coming from SMA.

The unskilled pilots, Steve Klafter, Rick Whitaker, and me, took the opportunity to fix things that were broken or waiting for something to break.

We closed the clinic around 4:30 and drove to street tacos in San Quintin. They were fast, cheap and delicious. We were back at the hotel by 6:30.

Saturday, May 12, 2018

We did our usual breakfast run to Mama's Restaurant in El Rosario. We got the clinic opened around 9:30. Everyone resumed the same roles as on Friday. However, the unskilled pilots were put to work servicing the vans. We checked all the fluid levels and gassed them up, of course, but we also put battery disconnect switches on the two vans that did have them. That was more of a project than it should have been, but we got it done (finally).

Aldofo showed back up and Dave and José spent the day getting the now modified prosthetic to fit properly. Aldofo was very pleased with the result.

Phoebe Blakeley is not a “new-bee” but has spent the last couple of years in dental school. Her last trip with us was in December 2016. Two weeks from the end of this clinic she’ll become a “real” dentist and will also be going into the Air Force. I talked to her a little about Air Force life, and she is certainly excited about the opportunity. She’ll be stationed at Scott AFB in Illinois after some orientation at Maxwell AFB in Alabama.
